

## Patient Medical Billing Map for Pfizer Oncology Injectable and Infusion Medicines

Together, you and your doctor will decide which treatment is right for you. Work with the office staff to understand your medical insurance coverage, treatment benefits, and costs. If you are prescribed a Pfizer Oncology medicine for outpatient use, see below to help better navigate your treatment coverage and billing process.



## Follow the path that matches your coverage type:

## Insurance Processes Claim

After the plan processes your claim and payment is made to your provider, you will receive an "Explanation of Benefits" which shows the amounts paid to your provider and your remaining cost responsibility (comprised of deductible, co-pay, or co-insurance amounts).

Office Collects Patient's Co-Payments Office bills and collects the remaining amounts you may owe. If you were approved for the Co-Pay Savings Program, work with your office staff to submit a co-pay claim to be used for the co-payments owed or to be reimbursed if you already paid the co-pay. Office Bills Patient Doctor's office bills you for any out-of-pocket cost-share responsibility, and may also request or apply co-payments from other alternate sources that were previously approved for you.
